- **PTA Sponsored Parent Workshops** – Conversations in Parenting Support Workshops in English, Spanish, and Cantonese were launched last week. The topic for next week's session is "Encouraging Positive Behavior: Strategies for Motivating and Reinforcing Your Child's Behavior."

These cards are a huge distraction to our learning environment and it's causing discipline problems that could be avoidable if students kept their cards at home (should not be kept in school backpack during the day). In order to address Pokémon problems, we've established a new school policy: Pokémon cards brought to school will be taken and kept in school for the rest of the school year and returned to students in June. If it's a chronic problem with particular students, we will request a parent conference. We will address this to the students during our all school assembly on

October 24, 2014.
