- **SPS Interim Superintendent Dr. Larry Nyland to Host and Meet Community Members** – Dr. Nyland who was appointed by the School Board in June to serve as Interim Superintendent, has outlined several opportunities this fall to meet with community members. These informal gatherings will include a few short remarks from Dr. Nyland, followed by time for an open question and answer period:

- **School Picture Day** – October 1<sup>st</sup> and October 2<sup>nd</sup>, picture retake day will be on November 10<sup>th</sup>.
- **Free Dress Day** – There will be no Free Dress day in September. Usually there is one Free Dress Day a month, when students don't have to wear their uniform. School Picture Day(s) are Oct. 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> and students do not have to wear their uniform on the day that they will be photographed. The following Free Dress Day will be Friday, October 31<sup>st</sup>. Since there will not be one in September, the students will have 2 in October.
- **Need Host Families** – We still need host families for our Chinese guest teacher from China for this school year. The hosting period will be from September to June. You can choose to host the teacher for two to three months at a time, half of the 10 months, or full 10 months.
